

# US 51 and County B/AB intersection

## Dane County

March 20, 2024

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is conducting a public involvement meeting to discuss road work on US 51 at the County B/AB intersection in the town of Dunn, Dane County. The meeting will be an informal, open house format with the WisDOT contractor and construction staff. It will take place from **4:30 to 6:00pm on Wednesday, April 10<sup>th</sup> at the Town of Dunn Town Hall (4156 County B, McFarland, WI 53558).**

### Project Plans

- Construct a dual-lane roundabout at the intersection of US 51 and County B/AB

### Traffic and access impacts

The US 51 & County B/AB roundabout will be constructed in four stages. Local access to properties on US 51 will be maintained through construction. Traffic impacts for each stage are described below:

Stage 1: No anticipated impacts to daily travel patterns. Night-time closures and detour of US 51 will be required to construct new culverts.

Stage 2: US 51 will be open to through traffic. County B (west) will be closed, and County AB (east) will be restricted to right-in & right-out access.

Stage 3: US 51 will be open to through traffic. County AB (east) will be closed, and County B (west) will be restricted to right-in & right-out access.

Stage 4: US 51 will be closed and detoured for 26 calendar days. Local access to County B (west) and County AB (east) will be open.

### Two-week construction schedule (subject to change)

#### Week of April 8th

- Setup traffic control
- Erosion control
- Saw cutting

#### Week of April 15th

- Removals
- Grade for temporary US 51 widening
- Construct culvert pipe crossing. Work requires overnight lane closures of US 51.

### Project schedule:

April 8, 2024: Start construction

Fall 2024: Construction complete
