- **If a check is made payable to property owner(s) AND the Town,** all payees must endorse the back. \$25.00 charge for returned checks. No post-dated checks. **If paying in cash, call 608-838-1081, ext. 1 to make an appointment. Bring the exact amount.**
- **Receipts** are mailed if you send us a self-addressed, STAMPED envelope. **Or print your own receipt or copy of your tax bill:** Visit accessdane.countyofdane.com, find your parcel(s), choose E-Receipt to view and print. Choose E-Bill for your tax bill copy.
- **Pay Dog License fees with a separate check.** See reverse side for dog license applications.
- **Please Avoid Parking** on roadsides during snow removal. Please indicate Town of Dunn on vehicle registrations.
- **Dunn Sanitary District Residents** can help keep costs down by ensuring that sump pump water, and non-flushable items such as wipes, dental floss, and grease are not put into the sewer. MMSD is raising the rates to all sanitary districts including Dunn.
- **Test Your Well for PFAS:** PFAS (forever chemicals) have been detected at hazard levels in some private wells in our area. Learn more about well testing and about filtering these chemicals out of drinking water, including free or reduced cost testing by contacting Dane County and Madison Public Health at (608) 242-6515 or by visiting their website at: www.publichealthmdc.com/environmental-health/environmental-hazards/pfas
