Roadside Mowing Exemption Form

The attached Town of Dunn Roadside mowing policy is designed to maintain roadsides in rural areas for safety, visibility, and drainage. Rural residents who prefer to maintain the road right-of-way with more frequent or selective mowing and maintenance, particularly near their residences, can request exemption with this form.

Residents who wish to mow and maintain an area of roadside should adhere to the following standards set by the Town of Dunn:

- Mow or trim any woody growth by October 1st.
- Remove noxious weeds anytime they appear. *The Wisconsin Statutes define noxious weeds as Leafy Spurge, Field Bindweed and Canadian Thistle. Other problem weeds that should be controlled are Wild Parsnip, Garlic Mustard, and Burdock.*
- An area at least 7-10 feet wide adjacent to the pavement must be mowed regularly to allow for parking a vehicle off the pavement.
- Vegetation must not obstruct visibility at intersections and driveways.
- Drainage ditches must remain unobstructed.
- Road right of way must remain free of obstructions, fences, boulders, rocks, timbers, pavers, or decorative landscape items.

The town will perform a fall mowing (Oct – Nov) of the roadsides to the edge of the right-of-way or fence line in all areas as needed.

I agree to maintain and mow an area of roadside located at, to the standards listed above:

I request that the Town avoid mowing the area identified on the attached drawing. I understand that the Town is not relinquishing its rights to mow, maintain, and use the road right-of-way. The Town may mow, trim, or use the road right-of-way at any time as it deems necessary. I will not hold the Town responsible for the loss or destruction of vegetation in the road right-of-way.
